



GIGA Graduate Courses in Genetics

University of Liège, Belgium

The GIGA Centre of Excellence has organized a series of graduate courses targeting six areas of genetics:

Population and evolutionary genetics
Quantitative genetics
Developmental genetics
Molecular biology of the gene
Genomics
Bioinformatics

The courses will be taught at the University of Liège by internationally recognized experts in their field. Individual courses will be given full-time, lasting two weeks each. Courses will succeed each other at six months intervals, jointly covering a three year period, i.e. the minimal duration of a PhD thesis. Courses will involve both theory and practicals. Number of attendants per course will be limited to 40.
